

AHANC/PACIFIC SLOPE COVID-19 EXHIBITOR AND TRAINER GUIDE MURIETA EQUINE CENTER JULY 1-4, 2020

There is not a way to eliminate all risks related to COVID-19. If you are uncomfortable in the setting please do not participate. The following requirements and recommendations are those of Federal, State, Local, WHO, CDC, USEF, AHA, and Murieta Equine Center. The COVID-19 Compliance /Resource Officer shall be Kathy Callahan-Smith 1-909-229-5459.

Limited Entry – Only one gate will be used for entrance to Murieta Equine Center. The gate shall be monitored and all entrants screened. Upon completion of screening and signing of waivers the entrant will receive a wristband to be worn for the entirety of the competition. Spectators, public and non-essential personnel will not be allowed entry.

Temperature - Participants and Support Personnel are required to self-monitor their temperatures daily. Thermometers are required to be provided. Anyone with temperatures of 99.5 or greater may not be present at the facility.

Symptoms – Anyone exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms cannot be present at the facility.

Face Coverings – Participants and Support Personnel are required to wear face coverings when in any setting where there is a possibility of being within six feet of other individuals. Participants may choose weather to wear a mask when mounted on a horse.

Social Distancing – All individuals must practice physical distancing as all times when on the competition grounds by staying at least six feet from any person who is not a member of their immediate household.

Hand Sanitation – Wash hands often and adhere to other sanitization practices during the day.

Bleachers – All seating and bleachers are closed. Exception – A Trainer may go into the seating area in order to coach a participant.

Spectators – No Spectators or Visitors will be permitted on the show grounds.

Equipment – All equipment is to be regularly sanitized including, but not limited to stable doors, buckets, tack, grooming, feeding and stall cleaning materials.

PPE – Masks and gloves to be provided for staff and other personnel. AHANC has a limited supply available. Hand Sanitizing stations will be located throughout the venue.

Access – Stabling areas are restricted to grooms, trainers and essential personnel. All stabling areas, tack rooms and display/seating areas to comply with best practices and social distancing.

Wash Racks – Use of gloves is strongly recommended when using community wash racks.

Awards – Awards shall be placed on horse/saddle/rider by ring personnel for those placing 1st, 2nd, Champion, Reserve Champion or Top Five and shall be removed by ring personnel at the out gate. Awards are not to be handled by anyone other than ring personnel. Ribbons and trophies will be available at the Award room.

Show Office – The Show Office is located in the new building. Walk up windows will be utilized and entrance will be granted by appointment only.

SHOULD AN INDIVIDUAL TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 WITHIN 14 DAYS OF COMPETITION SHOW MANAGEMENT MUST BE NOTIFIED SO THAT ALL APPROPRIATE ORGANIZATIONS AND INDIVIDUALS CAN BE NOTIFIED.

TRAINERS AND EXHIBITORS MUST ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR THEMSELVES AND THEIR STAFF WHILE ON SHOW GROUNDS. IF ANYONE VIOLATES THESE RULES AND GUIDELINES THEY WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE FACILITY.

ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY – USEF STEWARDS AND TECHNICAL DELEGATES WILL INFORM INDIVIDUALS WHEN THEY ARE NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMPETITION AND SHALL REPORT SUCH SITUATIONS TO THE COMPETITION ORGANIZER. THE COMPETITION ORGANIZER HAS THE AUTHORITY UNDER USEF GR 702.1 AND GR 914 TO REMOVE FROM THE FACILITY ANY PERSON WHO DOES NOT COMPLY WITH REGULATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS OF THE COMPETITION.
